“Where does your garbage go?” Pre-K thru K-3

- The Brevard County Solid Waste Management Department is proud to offer FREE in-class recycling education programs for preschool through third grade.
- In these thirty minute programs your students will learn about what happens to their garbage once they put it in the trash can.
- It's a short trip from the curb to the landfill as students follow the trail of their trash. They will learn how we take care of the landfill, the abundant wildlife that live there; and why it's important to **Reduce, Reuse & Recycle**.
- We also developed a fun recycling game. The students learn why it is important to recycle and what can go into their curbside recycling bin.
- If time permits, we also have a quick craft and the best part is we bring all the supplies!
- Our mascot “RC” the Recycling Cat travels with us. You will need to find a volunteer to wear the costume for the program. It's one size fits most.

“The World of Waste” Tour Grades 4,5 & 6

- Students will embark on an adventure through the “World of Waste” as they learn what happens to our garbage after it's picked up at the curbside.
- In this exciting FREE program, students will travel to Brevard County's Central Disposal Facility (landfill) located in Cocoa.
- Erin LeClair, Recycling Educator, will lead a tour on your bus through the facility. Students will see first hand where their trash goes.
- Following the tour we will have a brown bag lunch at F. Burton Smith Park in Cocoa.
- After lunch we will review the days events and play a fun “RECYCLE IT RIGHT” GAME WITH PRIZES FOR EVERYONE!
